About Fairfield PHAB

Fairfield PHAB is an inclusive youth group, where both non-disabled and disabled children and young people aged between 11 and 16 can come together on equal terms. During the late 80's and early 90's and under the leadership of Alice McMurray, Fairfield PHAB enjoyed a very successful era. During the mid 90's the Fairfield PHAB closed down. In 2005, whilst working at St John's Community Centre the former meeting place for Fairfield PHAB, ex-member Phil Peel was asked to re-establish PHAB within the Kensington and Fairfield area of Liverpool, and in January 2006 the new St John's PHAB opened it's doors for the very first time, under the leadership of Phil Peel.

In 2007, it was announced that St John's Community Centre would be closing down, it was decided that PHAB would remain open, but we would revert back to the original name of Fairfield PHAB. After 6 long months from December 2007 - June 2008, PHAB would not run any sessions and would basically cease to exist. In July 2008 we found new premises and we managed to keep the same PHAB team in place.
